DGS Training Circular No. 01 of 2024

Subject: - Collection of details of Shipboard training by the Recognized Organization (RO) before conducting the Comprehensive Inspection Programme (CIP) & MMDs for verification/re-inspection of the MTIs approved for the pre-sea courses. -reg.

1. Whereas, DGS Order No. 04 of 2016 dated 12.09.2016 mandates Comprehensive Inspection Programme (CIP) of Maritime Training Institutes (MTIs) for pre-sea training.
2. Whereas, the para 8 of the aforesaid DGS Order mentions that Authorised Classification Societies as Recognised Organisations (RO) (Annexure-II: 2 pages) shall carry out such inspection, gradation and certification of maritime training and education institutes under these revised guidelines. This methodology will assist in portraying maritime training and education in India holistically, with global transparency and objectivity and in perspective.
3. Whereas, the guidelines have been mentioned in the aforesaid DGS Order for conducting of CIP by the ROs and the details have been provided for the purpose of grading, a comprehensive Check-list has been prescribed there to guide the Inspecting authority for the uniform implementation of the inspection regime based on the key parameters including On-board Training Records.
4. Whereas, para 14.1 of the guidelines provided in the aforesaid DGS Order mentioned that on completion of the inspection, the Recognised Organization shall provide the institute a complete report of the inspection, with clear recommendation on the final Grading, and forward the same to the Directorate General of Shipping within ten working days, in case of Initial and renewal inspection, and within five working days in case of annual inspection. A copy of the report shall also be forwarded to the PO of the jurisdictional MMD.
5. Whereas, para 1.4.2.2 of DGS Order No. 07 of 2016 dated 17.11.2016 mentions that Application from an existing Institute shall hereinafter be processed for approval for increase in intake in any pre-sea and for approval of new pre-sea courses only if the Institute has been (a) graded A1 or A2 grading in the pre-sea CIP and complies with minimum 80% placement record, (b) meets the requirements of these guidelines (c) shows evidence to the satisfaction of DGS about placement of additional batches.
6. Whereas, para 1.12.3 of DGS Order No. 07 of 2016 dated 17.11.2016 mentions that Institutes are to ensure placement for on board training with Indian Shipping Companies or DGS approved RPSL of a minimum of 85% of all its trainees who have passed out from the GP Ratings course within a period of 12 months from the date of passing out/examination result.
