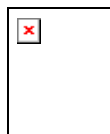

In case of any change of ownership it is important for the protection of the interests of all parties that the change should be registered according to law. *Changes of ownership, address or other registered particulars should be notified to the Registrar at the Port of Registry.* Should the ship be either actually or constructively lost, taken by the enemy, burnt or broken up or cease for any reason to be an Indian ship notice thereof, together with the Certificate of Registry if in existence, should immediately be given to the Registrar of Indian Ships at the Port of Registry under a Penalty which may extend to Rs. 1000/- for default.
