The written examinations of Skippers and Mate of Fishing Vessels, Dredge Masters and Dredge Mates are divided into one/two/three parts to satisfy the requirements of Merchant Shipping (Examination for Skippers and Mate of Fishing Vessels) Rules 1987 & (Examination of Dredge Masters & Dredge Mates) Amendment Rules 1993. The number of written subjects in these part(s) is different for different grades of examination e.g. in part B written examination of Dredge Master Grade-II, candidates need to appear for five subjects. To pass part B, candidates should be successful in all the subjects in a particular attempt. In other words, failure in one subject makes the candidate unsuccessful in that part and the subject(s) that he passed need to be repeated again in the next attempt. This norm is applicable to all grades of examination of above MS (Examination) Rules.

To facilitate candidates clear the examination expeditiously without compromising with competence standards, it has been decided that the subject(s) in which candidates are successful need not be repeated to pass a particular part of any written examination conducted as per above MS (Examination) Rules. The results declared on or after 20.09.2007 will provide the information whether candidates have been pass/fail in a particular subject. Accordingly, the candidates need to write examination only in subject(s) in which they are declared failed. The validity of the passed subject is limited to five year from the month of the examination in which the candidate has been declared passed in a particular subject.

This circular does not alter the prevalent fee structure and fees as payable to appear in a particular part may continue to prevail.
