As per Meta Manual Vol. I - Flow Diagram No.1 (page III/7) and under section M-III/1 subsection para 4.7 (page III/4), candidate with a naval background wishing to appear for MEO Class IV Part A Examination has to satisfactorily complete an approved six months Modular Training Course, and meet the standards of competence specified in Section A-III/1 of STCW Code, prior to appearing for examination. At present, no institute is conducting this course, as the numbers of candidates are very few. So it has been decided to allow these candidates to do a 3 months course covering section A-III/1 of STCW Code read with A-I/3 as per Flow Diagram No.4 for NCV page III/19 of the Meta Manual Vol.I. After successfully completion of the course and examination from approved institute from where candidate has under gone this course, he will be required to complete a 3 months course for MEO Class IV Part A covering the syllabus of Heat Engines, Applied Mechanics, Mathematics, and Engineering Drawing. At present this course is being conducted by Institute of Marine Engineers, Mumbai.
