<b>Sub: MEO-CL-I Preparatory Course</b>		
<p>It has come to the notice of the Directorate that some MEO Class I candidates have been completing the 'Diesel Engine Combustion Gas Monitor' simulator course comprising of 18 hours as conducted on three Saturdays (each of 6 hours duration) concomitantly with their MEO Class I Preparatory Course.</p> <p>This practice has been reviewed and it has been decided to allow candidates to appear for the MEO Class I examination, who have completed the 'Diesel Engine Combustion Gas Monitor' simulator course concomitant with the MEO Class I Preparatory course as stated above, before 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2010 only.</p> <p>From 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2010, all candidates must attend the 'Diesel Engine Combustion Gas Monitor' simulator course separate from the MEO Class I Preparatory course and not concomitantly as is being resorted to by some candidates presently.</p> <p>Candidates, who have completed the 'Diesel Engine Combustion Gas Monitor' simulator course concomitant with the MEO Class I Preparatory course as stated above, before 01<sup>st</sup> May 2010 will not be accepted for examination after 01<sup>st</sup> August 2010.</p> <p>This issues with the approval of the Chief Examiner of Engineers.</p>
