DG Shipping Order No. 13 of 2014

(Corrigendum to the DG Shipping Order Nos. 8 of 2013, 09 of 2013 & 06 of 2014)

Sub: Issuance of Indian CDCs to hospitality crew working on cruise vessels and also to seafarers who are working on board trading vessels without an Indian CDC – reg.


The Director General Shipping Order No. 8 of 2013 [F. No. CR/CDC (Special)/ 2013] dated 22.03.13, has enabled an issuance of Continuous Discharge Certificates-cum-Seafarer's Identity Documents (CDCs) for additional categories of Indian seafarers, such as hospitality crew currently working on cruise vessels without any Indian CDCs. Corrigendum were issued with the said order vide DGS Order 09 of 2013 [F. No. CR/CDC(Special)/2013] dated 10.04.13 & 06 of 2014 [F. No. CR/CDC (Special)/2013] dated 06.06.14.

2. The following corrigendum is now effected in the said DG Shipping Order No. 6 of 2014, mutatis – mutandis;

1.	6.2.5	A letter of intent[in original] from a licensed RPS company which is engaged in the business of recruiting Indian seafarers for cruise vessels, with self attested documentary proof of a valid tie up agreement between such a company and ship-owners/ employers concerned for the recruitment of seafarers for cruise vessels".	The application shall accompany with a letter of intent [in original] from a licensed RPS provider which is engaged in the business of recruiting Indian seafarers for cruise vessels. Such letter of intent shall also indicate the name and address of the principals "of RPS" as given in Form IX for managing their ships by the said RPS.

Note: Such RPS providers who are giving letter of intent for any CDC applicant, however, should have already submitted (to the concerned DSEO) the Form IX and a documentary proof of a valid tie up agreement between the said RPS and ship-owners/ employers concerned for the recruitment of seafarers of cruise vessels" for which letter of intent has been given to the applicant by the said RPS as required under RPS rules.

3. All the other terms & conditions of the said DGS Orders No. 8, 9 of 2013 & 06 of 2014 remain unchanged.
