**DG Shipping Order No. 19 of 2014**

(Corrigendum to the DG Shipping Order Nos. 8 of 2013, 09 of 2013, 06 of 2014 and 13 of 2014)

Sub: Issuance of Indian CDCs to hospitality crew working on cruise vessels and also to seafarers who are working on board trading vessels without an Indian CDC -reg.


This office DG Shipping Order No. 8 of 2013 [F. No. CR/CDC (Special)/ 2013] dated 22.03.13, on the aforesaid subject has enabled an issuance of Continuous Discharge Certificates (CDCs) to additional categories of Indian seafarers, such as hospitality crew working on cruise vessels and also those working with experience on board trading vessels, without an Indian CDC. Corrigenda were issued to the said Order, vide the subsequent DGS Order Nos. 09 of 2013 [F. No. CR/CDC (Special)/2013] dated 15.04.13, 06 of 2014 [F. No. CR/CDC (Special)/2013] dated 06.06.14 & DGS Order No. 13 of 2014 [F. No. CR/CDC (Special)/2013] dated 26.08.14.

2. Para nos. 6.1.4. & 6.3.4. of the original said DGS Order No. 08 of 2013 was modified by issuing a corrigendum thereto in the said later DGS Order No. 09 of 2013 & DGS Order No. 15 of 2014 [F. No. CR/CDC (Special)/2013] dated 29.10.14. The same is now, with a view to further streamlining the system and to bring about procedural simplification thereof, further modified as here-in-under;

2.	6.3.4. [for seafarers with experience on board trading vessels]	Two years of sea experience, on board a merchant vessel. The said sea experience should be on a foreign CDC, duly authenticated for the entire period of such service claimed, self-attested copies of which have to be submitted, alongwith self-attested copies of the corresponding Indian passport immigration entries concerned. The candidates have to also submit their original passports for verification, the detailed procedure of which is given herein below. The CDC will be issued in the rank last served.	Two years of sea experience, on board a merchant vessel. The said sea experience should be on a foreign CDC, duly authenticated for the entire period of such service claimed, self-attested copies of which have to be submitted, alongwith self-attested copies of the corresponding Indian passport immigration entries concerned. This is provided the applicant should have been engaged & placed by a Recruitment & Placement of Seafarers (RPS) service provider registered under the M.S. (RPS) Rules, 2005, as amended, for the sea service concerned.
<p><b>Note:</b> (i) In the light of the above amendments, the extant requirement of the submission of the original passport by an applicant is hereby dispensed with.</p> <p>(ii) The requirement of an affidavit on a ₹ 100 stamp paper to the effect that the sea service claimed is genuine and has been performed by the applicant on the particular vessel(s) for the said period. (In Original) as required under para 6.1.5. of DGS Order No. 08 of 2013 &amp; subsequently modified at para 4 of DGS Order No. 09 of 2013 is dispensed with. Instead an applicant shall submit a self-certificate, to that effect, in the prescribed proforma enclosed with this Order [Annexure-I : 1 page].</p>			

3. Mutatis- mutandis, all the other terms & conditions of the said DGS Orders No. 8 & 9 of 2013 and 06 & 13 of 2014, shall remain unchanged.
