In this regard, the medical examiners approved by the Directorate are required to register themselves in the e-governance system. 2. The DG approved medical examiners are requested to verify the details provided therein for correctness and confirm to the Directorate by email to dgstrg@gmail.com. Any ambiguity, discrepancies may also please be informed on the same email ID latest by 28.01.2018.

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3. Upon confirmation from medical examiners, the Directorate shall issue a user ID and password to the medical examiners.

4. The medical examiners shall be required to upload the fitness of seafarers in e-governance system. The Medical Examiners may follow the steps below for entering the medical fitness details of Indian seafarers.

Step 1 : Go to www.dgshipping.gov.in.

Step 2 : Click on "egovernance".

Step 3 : Login to the system & go to "medical fitness".

Step 4 : Go to "Submit application" & click on "fitness certificate".

Step 5 : Enter INDoS No. & click on "Get Seafarers Details".

Step 6 : Enter the 'Date of Examination' and select 'Medically Fit' YES/NO.


Step 7 : Enter the relevant details of medical certificate issued to seafarer.

Step 8 : Click on the 'Add' button.

Step 9 : The medical fitness details of seafarers are submitted.

5. Please be informed that it is mandatory to enter medical fitness of seafarers as per the above procedure from 01.02.2018.
